

## Jewellery award and fellowship prize 2011:

# The South Seas

For centuries, the South Seas have inspired buccaneers, explorers and dreamers alike – now it is the jewellery designers turn.

All the pieces of jewellery created for the South Seas topic and their accompanying stories will be virtually exhibited on our homepage (and on Facebook) and also presented in the elaborate exhibition documentation. In November 2010, a pre-judging will take place by means of the sent in photos and texts. Thereby, the work of approximately 40-50 participants will be selected. These items will not only be presented virtually, but also physically, at our exhibition room "Trüffel" at Friends of Carlotta gallery.

In February 2011, an independent jury will select the best of the 40-50 works and award it the FoC jewellery award and fellowship prize 2011. As always, the audience prize will be awarded by the visitors of the exhibition.

The works that were nominated for the virtual exhibition will also be on display in "Trüffel" at Friends of Carlotta. They will be shown on a screen as well as in the available exhibition documentation.
